Several of the newspaper articles were discussed including a Genoa Township zoning amendment referendum involving the density of a proposed subdivision, the court ordered removal of the Harlem Township self-storage referendum from the ballot, the proposed Planet

Oasis project in Berkshire Township, and the on-going Fairview Cemetery conflict in Berlin Township. A revised Build-out Map for Kingston Township was distributed to Members referenced as Item 2 and briefly discussed. Finally, a news article from the Ohio Township News referenced as Item 3 was distributed and discussed. The article covered the differences between zoning resolutions and comprehensive plans for townships.
