issued during the period, and discussed several complaints. Talbott also discussed the Yearly Recap of Permit Activity for 2019, and proposed plan expansion submitted by Susan Barr for True North Veteran Support approved as an Agricultural Exemption in 2018.

A number of newspaper articles from The Delaware Gazette and ThisWeek Community News from October, November and December, 2019 and January, 2020 were distributed for Member information *referenced as Item 2* including pertinent issues facing Kingston and other townships in the county.
